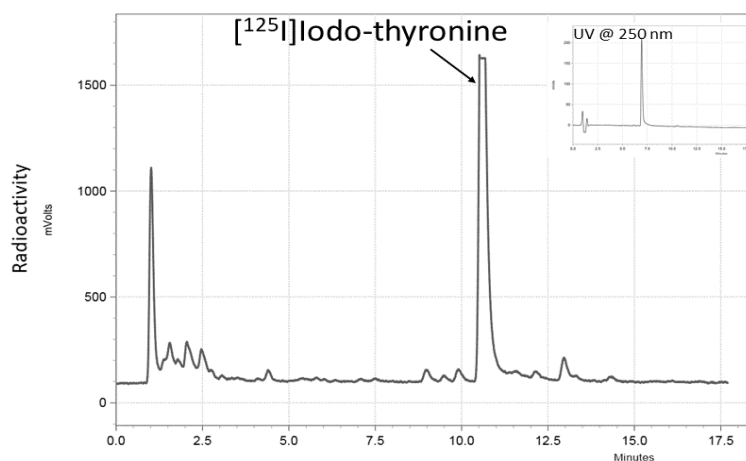

Fig. 1. Radiosynthesis and HPLC purification of [¹²⁵I]iodo-thyronine prepared using the iodogen method.



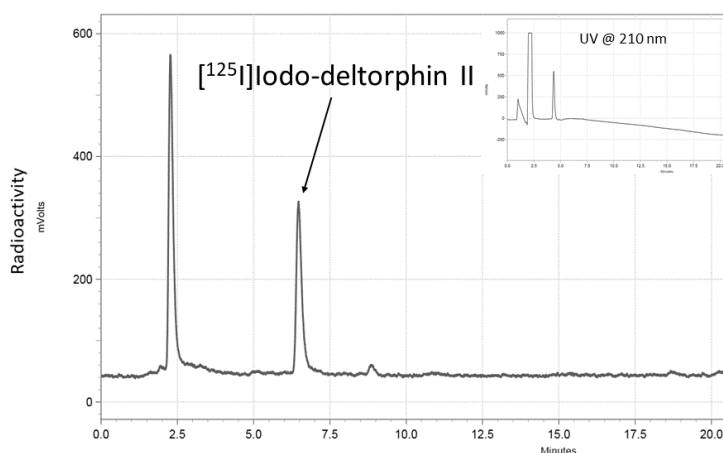
HPLC conditions

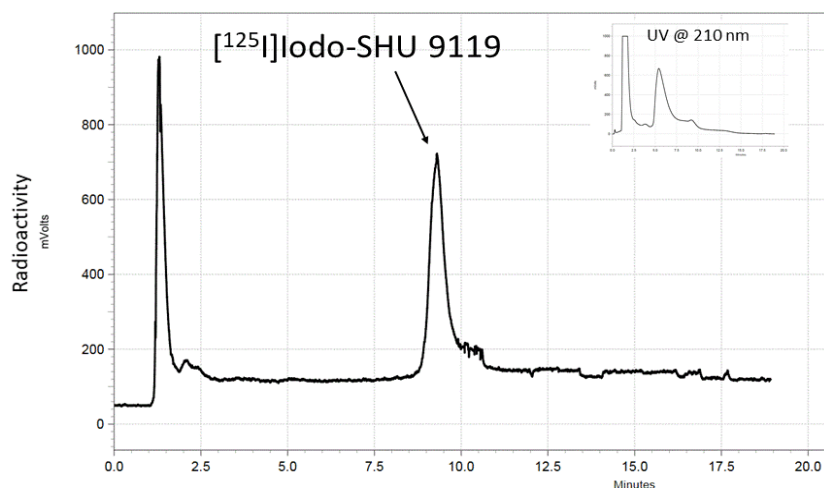
HPLC conditions

Fig 3. Radiosynthesis and HPLC purification of [¹²⁵I]iodo-SHU 9119 prepared via the lactoperoxidase method.



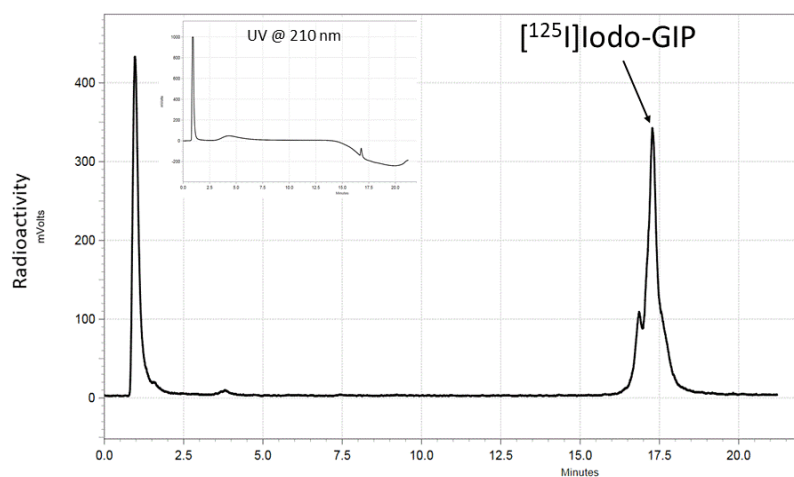

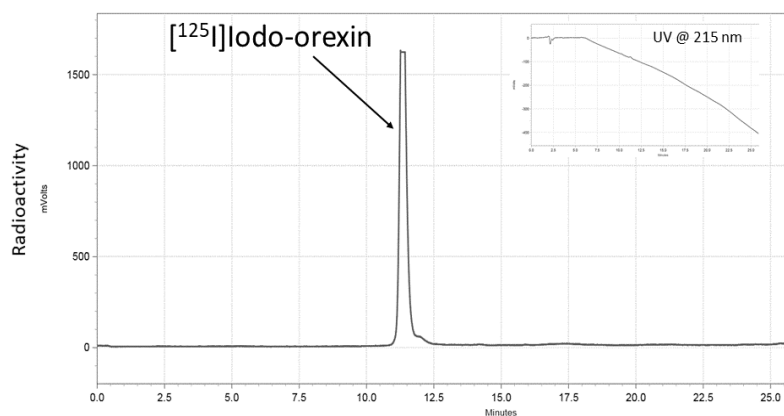
HPLC conditions

Fig. 5. QC check on HPLC-purified [¹²⁵I]iodo-orexin.



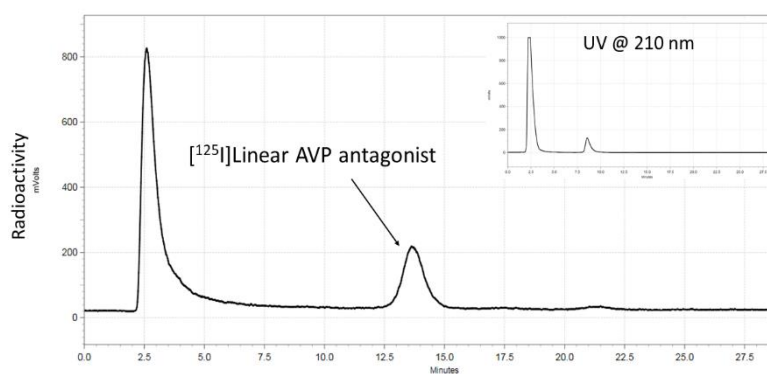
HPLC conditions

HPLC conditions

Column: C18 4.7 x 10 mm

Mobile phase: Gradient 30 – 50 % MeOH, 0.1 % TFA

Flow rate: 0.4 ml/min
